21. 1965: Convention between Schegal and Gambia

Signed at Bathurst on 18 February 1965. This established an Inter-State Committee for the integrated development of the Gambia River basin. (Cahiers Afrique Occidentale Afrique Equatoriale, 6 March 1965; Marchés Tropicaux, 18 February 1965 and 26 February 1965).

22. 1967: Treaty of Association between Senegal and the Gambia

Signed at Bathurst on 19 April 1967. This created an Inter-State Ministerial Committee which was to meet at least once a year. This Committee was to supervise the work of all committees established under former agreements between the Gambia and Senegal, including the Committee for the integrated development of the Gambia River Basin.

23. 1967: A Joint Communiqué issued at the first meeting of The Sene-Gambia Inter-State Ministerial Committee, held on 9 and 10 June 1967, established the machinery for a permanent executive secretariat.

Gambia River Basin was adopted at the third meeting of the Sene-Gambia Inter-State Ministerial Committee held on 30-31 July 1968. The Agreement, dated 31 July 1968 and superceding the 1965 Convention, (see para. 21) stated that a Development Programme would be prepared as a basis for applications for international assistance. (Joint Communique issued by the Information Office, Bathurst on 1 August 1968)
